- Metal Cans & Empty Aerosol Cans: Aluminum, Steel, Tin
- Plastics: Food, beverage, personal care & household plastic containers
- Glass Bottles & Jars: Green, Clear, Brown
- Aluminum Pie Tins & Food Trays
- Milk & Juice Cartons
- Newspapers & Inserts
- Corrugated Cardboard
- Mixed Paper: Catalogs, Junk Mail, Magazines, Paper Egg Cartons, Envelopes, Office Paper, Phone Books, Glossy Paper, Post-it Notes, Cereal Boxes, Brown Paper Bags, Paper Towel Rolls, Shredded Paper (placed in paper bag with top rolled down)

## What May NOT Be Recycled?



- Styrofoam
- Plastic Bags
- Dishes or Cookware
- Drinking Glasses
- Aluminum Foil
- Light Bulbs
- Plastic Wrap
- Paper Towels, Napkins or Tissue
- Window or Mirror Glass
- Black Microwavable Trays
- Batteries

# Recycling Program

The Town of Biltmore Forest is pleased to announce that beginning March 7, 2016, the Town will begin home recycling pick-up.

Recycling will be picked up every other week on the same day as your current garbage pick-up. A full schedule can be found on the opposite page.

The recycling container will be provided by the Town and remains property of the Town.

*In 2015 229.34 tons of materials were recycled by our Residents; this is an increase of 12.34 tons from 2014. Thank you for keeping 458,680 pounds of recyclables out of the landfill!*

## Prepare Recyclables



- ✓ Empty all containers, bottles and containers
- ✓ Break down & flatten corrugated cardboard
- ✓ Secure the lid to your container to prevent objects from blowing out
- ✓ Set your recyclables out by 7am on your recycling day



**Moving In?** Please speak with your moving company regarding disposal of large numbers of cardboard boxes.

**Moving Out?** Please leave the Town recycling container at the residence for the new occupants.
